

SRC EARTHQUAKE PREPS – OVERVIEW
NEIGHBOR HELPING NEIGHBOR

We are interested citizens who have attended the Certified Emergency Response Training (C.E.R.T.) and do not purport to be experts. We offer these suggestions as interested citizens, in no official capacity, as a way to have neighbors helping neighbors should a major earthquake (or other disaster) occur. This is not an official plan of any person or organization.

The plan is simple and may prevent panic and chaos.

The SRC map shows the seven (7) sections into which SRC is divided for this Plan's purposes. Each Section has 1-2 Section Captains who will try to make sure all neighbors are accounted for.

Each individual household is responsible for their own preparations. See the separate link and "Tips" page for information on getting prepared.

Stay in your home until the shaking stops. Put on sturdy shoes (watch for broken glass). If you are okay, place the yellow flag at the end of your driveway (where you place trash for pick up). This becomes a signal that you are okay.

If you know of someone needing special assistance during a disaster please let your Section Captain or one of us know name, address, phone number, and type of assistance that would be needed.

DO NOT smoke, light a match or any fire in case of a gas leak!
