### **IMPORTANT HEALTH INFO:** (Source VECTOR (Mosquitoes) CONTROL – Jill Oviatt

1. **Palm Springs has been hard hit by an invasion of disease carrying mosquitoes.** They arrived in the Valley 2016 and have now spread infesting between 5-8000 homes.

- This variety bites during the day, rather than evenings/nights.
- It is aggressive and bites all day long.
- Some of the diseases carried include: yellow fever, dengue fever, & Zika
- They do not move on or fly away; once they are in an area they stay!

2. Vector Control is taking aggressive actions –

- Helicopter spraying garnered complaints
- Vector Control is going door-to-door to find mosquito “nurseries” and to eliminate them
- Now using truck-based spraying in neighborhoods near the mountains – weekly through the end of October

3. WHAT CAN WE DO?

- Eliminate standing water! Fountains should be emptied once a week and scrubbed thoroughly. The eggs can lay dormant in an area (even a dry one) and wait for the water. The scrubbing eliminates the eggs.
- Plants with saucers catch water – eliminate the saucers.
- Look around your patios/yard for other water catchment devices and eliminate them

4. VECTOR CONTROL SAYS:

- Dump it...Drain it...Scrub it
